Percy O. Peterson (1877-1941)

Dr. P. O. Peterson, the handwriting supervisor and penman of Greensburg, Pa., died of a heart attack on January 26, 1941. He was 64 years of age and had been in supervision work for thirty years. Dr. Peterson was an elder of the First Evangelical and Reformed Church, a member of the Odd Fellows lodge and a Rotarian.

He conducted the Peterson Business College of Scottdale, Pa.

In a recent visit to The Educator, to which he was a subscriber for many years, he appeared hale and hearty and full of penmanship enthusiasm. He was a firm believer in having a trained teacher supervisor the handwriting in every community.

Dr. Peterson attended the Zanerian College in 1902. In 1911 and again in 1926 he sent his sister, Elizabeth, to the Zanerian.
