These tablets produce an ink of strictly Zanerian Excellence quality. They are put up in appropriate round wooden boxes and each box contains 32 tablets. Most ink bottles are made in sizes ranging from one to thirty-two ounces. Simply drop one tablet in a one-ounce bottle filled with water, and you will immediately have a one-ounce bottle of good ink. Put two tablets in a two-ounce bottle and so on; 16 in a pint bottle and the entire 32 tablets in 2 quart. If one tablet is dropped into an ordinary ink well filled with water more water can be added from time to time and good results secured.

These tablets are easy to divide according to quantity of ink desired. They are also easily handled no scattering of the particle or soiling of the fingers.
